I am NEUTRAL on [SB 1527].

From the TEXT of [SB 1527],

"...SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section:

(a)(A) "Cervical cancer screening" means health care services or products provided to an individual without apparent symptoms of an illness, injury or disease, as recommended by the United States Preventive Services Task Force as grade A or B or as recommended by the Health Resources and Services Administration's guidelines, for the purpose of detecting the presence of cervical cancer or precancerous lesions.

(B) "Cervical cancer screening" does not include services that occur primarily for the treatment of diagnosed cervical cancer..."

"Section 2" sets the stage of [SB 1527], Get screened for cervical cancer, follow-up related screenings are to be covered by insurance but...if it is determined the patient has cervical cancer, the trap-door of insurance coverage is sprung and the patient is left hanging on the rope of being insured or nor insured for future treatment of cervical cancer.

For the 'uninsured patient' economic doom (as well as physical demise) is now upon you and 'No' one deserves these burdens.

[SB 1527] solves 'death' by a thousand co-pays (which I fully support).

[SB 1527] does not cover the more important step of including the broader and far more expensive, treatment for cervical cancer.
