Dear Chair Prozanski Vice-Chair Thatcher, and members of the Senate Judiciary Committee,

I'm Kathy Hanavan and I live in Bend, Oregon. I'm writing in strong support for HB 4088 A.

With increasing attacks from the federal administration on reproductive rights and LGBTQ+ health care, patients are concerned for the continuity of their care and health care professionals are fearful for their safety. This bill is critical in safeguarding patient privacy, protecting medical providers from mounting criminalization threats, and ensuring that all Oregonians can receive the health care they need without fear or discrimination. Providers should be able to deliver it without fear of federal intimidation or retaliation.

I know firsthand how important reproductive and LGBTQ+ health care is because I was an NP for many years before I retired and I would be most upset if I could not practice my ethics without retaliation. HB 4088A protects access to evidence-based health care in Oregon, including the rights of all Oregonians to make personal medical decisions with their physician, without fear or intimidation of government interference.

As federal and out-of-state threats escalate, Oregon has a responsibility to protect its providers' ability to practice medicine and protect personally identifiable patient data and identity records.

I urge you to vote YES on HB 4088 A to protect patients, providers, and privacy in Oregon. Thank you for your time, service, and commitment to the people of Oregon.
