NO on HB 4088

This bill declares this state's policy to protect engagement in certain activities relating to reproductive health care and gender-affirming treatment. The Act says that it is the policy of this state to make sure "PEOPLE" are allowed to get certain kinds of health care, including care for their bodies and gender identity. The Act also makes changes to laws about helping the federal government and other states in cases arising involving this kind of care, makes some records and information private and says that midwives who give this kind of care will not get in trouble if they follow the rules. "PEOPLE" has no age limit and intends to include children.

It's a federal crime to mutilate the body of a child and it is morally wrong to mutilate a child who is suffering from psychological and mental illnesses such as gender dysphoria, a serious mental health disorder according to the American and International Psychiatric associations' who put together the DSM's 1-5. It is violating EO 14187, January 28, 2025, and risking losing all Federal funding, which you want to tax us, the LEGAL taxpaying citizens, to Kingdom Come to make up for your rebellion.

Abortion and gender reassignment are legally, morally, and ethically wrong. Bloodletting at the anti-God altar of humanism and self-indulgence is murder and shameful. On top of that you want to protect this taxpayer-funded extinguishment of innocent life. We DO NOT support the curse that you are inflicting on the people of our state. If you truly understood what you are doing you wouldn't do it. The deception and moral blindness is staggering. HB 4088 extends immunity to providers and all those who "assist" or "attempt" to provide care, which is in no way exhibiting any kind of care and will open the door to some serious legal challenges when years later these people figure out what they have done, the lawsuits will never end.
