Attention Senate Committee on Veterans, Emergency Management, Federal and World Affairs, regarding HB 4091. I oppose this Bill.

"...(3) Neither the Governor, the Adjutant General, nor any officer or employee of the state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, may facilitate, assist, or coordinate in the

mobilization of a service member or unit of the Oregon National Guard that is called into active service if the active service is for law enforcement duties or immigration enforcement duties. For purposes of this subsection, "immigration enforcement duties" does not include support, logistics, or surveillance duties that are part of a border security operation."

May I say, "This is what happens when we have a Rogue Governor and an Administration that rules by politics versus the safety of Oregonians."

President Donald Trump's escalating rhetoric about Portland peaked when he seized control of 200 Oregon National Guard troops to deploy to what he claimed was a "war-ravaged" city. Almost immediately, state and local Democratic leaders sued to block the extraordinary move and sought a temporary restraining order to stop the deployment.
