


How Oregon hospitals support local economies

in total economic impacts, which includes **\$8.8 billion** direct hospital labor income




159k jobs

House District #9

- ◆ **\$512 million** in total economic impacts, which includes **\$216 million** direct hospital labor income
- ◆ **2,390** estimated total jobs, which includes **1,620** direct hospital employees

House District #10

- ◆ **\$536 million** in total economic impacts, which includes **\$114 million** direct hospital labor income
- ◆ **2,790** estimated total jobs, which includes **900** direct hospital employees

Oregon hospitals not only provide life-saving health care services to millions of people, but also they play an important role in the local and state economy.

Hospitals hire local workers with a range of skills and salaries, and buy a wide variety of goods and services, many of which come from Oregon-based businesses. The Hospital Association of Oregon hired ECONorthwest to measure the economic impact of hospitals. Using the IMPLAN input-output model, ECONorthwest calculated the direct and indirect effects of hospital spending as it flows through the economy.
