

Hello and thank you for hearing my concerns.

I am concerned that parents could have difficulty getting their children's medical records. I believe parents generally have much more concern and enduring interest in the welfare of their own children than the vast majority of state employees and other professionals.

I encourage including a provision explicitly clarifying that the parents of minors will be entitled to the medical records of any minor children which they have legal guardianship of, unless there is a court order explicitly stating otherwise. Failure to provide these records would entitle those parents to \$25,000 per incident plus reasonable lawyer fees.

I am also concerned about the possible information sharing limitation of this law in a child trafficking context. If not already present, I encourage adding an exemption for all information sharing provisions of this law when working with law enforcement for human trafficking related investigations.
