RE: Support H.B.4134 A, 1.25% for Wildlife

Chair Broadman, Vice-Chair McLane, and Members of the Committee:

On behalf of the Coalition of Oregon Land Trusts (COLT), we would like to share our strong support for H.B. 4134 A, to provide long-term and sustainable funding to support Oregon's fish, wildlife and habitats.

COLT is a membership organization representing 32 land trusts, soil and water conservation districts, and conservation organizations working across Oregon to protect our habitat and natural spaces – for all people, forever. Collectively, our members have protected more than 782,000 acres of land across our state.

H.B. 4134 A would increase the state transient lodging tax to provide dedicated funding for the Oregon State Wildlife Action Plan (SWAP) and support efforts to recover our most at-risk species and habitats. The bill would also provide funding to the Oregon Conservation and Recreation Fund and ODFW's Wildlife Connectivity Program, and support invasive species response, anti-poaching efforts, and wildfire risk reduction.

Land trusts in Oregon are already working in partnership with local partners to protect critical habitats that support wildlife connectivity and species recovery. Over the last 34 years, Greenbelt Land Trust has protected 4,000 acres in the Willamette Valley and is currently restoring habitat at three properties key to the recovery of Fender's Blue Butterfly: Lupine Meadows, Bald Hill Farm, and Mulkey Ridge Forest. Thanks to the work of Greenbelt Land Trust and a strong network of conservation
