As we continue to expand into wilderness areas, I also see the devastating effects on our wildlife. They're being driven from their habitats and many of their lives are cut short by cars, development, and human conflict.

Oregon's wildlife and natural landscapes are central to our identity, economy, and quality of life. Most of the modest 1.25% lodging tax increase is paid by out-of-state visitors, and Oregon would remain among the lowest lodging tax states in the country.
