"...SECTION 1.

...(1) As used in this section:

(a) "Data broker" has the meaning given that term in ORS 646A.593.

(b) "Personally identifiable information" has the meaning given that term in ORS 432.005. (c) "Public body" has the meaning given that term in ORS 174.109.

...(2)(a) Except as provided in subsection

?...(3) of this section, a public body may not disclose personally identifiable information to a data broker unless the data broker first provides a written attestation to the public body that the information will not be sold or otherwise transferred to any entity that will use the information to enforce federal immigration law..."

***[SB 1587 A] is another attempt to circumvent Federal Immigration Law.
