NO on HB 4138

HB 4138 – would require law enforcement agencies operating in Oregon to implement policies to ensure the officer is easily identifiable.

DHS says that this would put agents' lives at risk. According to the federal agency, ICE agents are facing a 1,150% increase in assaults and an 8,000% increase in death threats. ICE is targeting highly sophisticated gangs and criminal networks. These entities will target agents, their spouses, and their children if they are identifiable.

A Federal judge just blocked California's version of this bill. Oregon must comply and assist Federal law enforcement officials in doing their jobs. Anything else is open rebellion and treason.

State legislators it's time for you to get in touch with the laws of the land, the constitution, and the way the law works. Federal law trumps state law as set up under the US constitution and affirmed by the US Supreme Court. This is called the supremacy clause.
