These programs rely on the certainty of future jobs in order to move potential apprentices off waiting lists and into Oregon's skilled trades workforce.

When this project breaks ground in 2027, skilled trades workers will come from all over Oregon to work on this once-in-a-generation job site. From apprentices who earn while they learn to journey workers training the next generation, our workforce stands ready to meet this moment.
