I am opposes to this legislation for several reasons.

- 1) The US 2nd Ammendment states, "the right of the people to keep and bear Arms, shall not be infringed."
- 2) This creates a barrier to firearm ownership by adding a requirement that someone has wealth.
- 3) This bill was passed out the House Committee on Judiciary by a vote placed by a committee member under duress.
- 4) This bill would increase wait time from up to 30 days to up to 60 days. An increased wait time could put a victim of violence at risk of more violence without defense.
- 5) This bill would require any challenges to occur in Marion County, which would put a hardship on someone in Southern or Eastern Oregon who would have to travel to represent themself in court.
- 6) ORS 14.050 states, actions are to be brought where the case arose.
