Measure, Appointment or Topic: HB4145

Attention Committee on Rules, regarding HB 4145 regarding modifying the firearm permit provisions of Ballot 114 (2022). I absolutely agree with the Oregon Hunters Association opposing this Bill. Echoing this statement, the increased time allowed for issuance of the permit, from 30 to 60 days, further lengthens the time an individual will wait for their right to purchase a firearm to be approved by the government. Note, this 60 day interal comes after the individual has already taken the required training course, but before the additional background check and wait period, making the process to purchase a firearm span multiple months.
