In the 2022 Bruen Decision, the Supreme Court said that States may not create an Undue Burden on citizens seeking to exercise their 2nd Amendment rights. HB 4145 does not abide by this decision. It creates an Undue Burden on citizens who are lower income and those who are disabled, as well as those who are victims of Domestic Violence by creating an extended, bureaucratic pathway to protecting ourselves. There is no provision in this bill for how someone who is disabled, like me, is supposed to be able to take a class in order to get a permit to exercise a right that is guaranteed by both the 2nd Amendment and the Oregon State Constitution. This bill is clearly as Unconstitutional as Measure 114. Please vote No
