Measure, Appointment or Topic: HB4145

In 2022, Oregon voters passed Measure 114 in response to the ongoing threat of gun violence in our schools, homes, and communities. The measure does not eliminate Second Amendment rights. Instead, it establishes a permit-to-purchase system, limits large-capacity magazines, and closes loopholes to help reduce gun deaths and suicides. These are reasonable, voter-approved public safety protections.

HB 4145 makes necessary technical updates to ensure Measure 114 can be implemented effectively following review by the Oregon Supreme Court. Supporting this bill affirms the will of Oregon voters and advances practical gun safety measures that will save lives.
