 - It enables Oregon State Police to set rules/law on magazine limitations and labeling in the future.
 - This is no longer a 'Shall' issue permit with the clause that it may be denied based on a subjective ruling, etc.
 - The fees are ridiculous and the delays are unacceptable, including the training requirements
 - It requires a registry of gun owners that can be misused or breached, which is a direct violation of federal law.
 - It requires all legal challenges to be completed through Marion Circuit Court.
